- 9:30 - 10:15** **Current State of Energy in Ohio** (*Eric Romich*) - Learn how energy development has impacted communities across Ohio. This session will outline factors influencing energy development decisions and provide an overview of electricity generation in Ohio, analyze past trends, and future projections.
- 10:15 - 10:45** **Overview of Energize Ohio Signature Program** (*Eric Romich*) - This session will review the signature program website and provide an overview curriculum materials and teaching tools. In addition, we will discuss program cost and various methods for customizing the design and delivery of the materials to meet local needs.

- **Renewable Energy Workshop** (*Nancy Bowen & Myra Moss*) - This group will review a simulation exercise based on experiences in three Ohio communities. Participants will come to understand how to assess a community's suitability for renewable energy development and how to prepare local residents.
 - **Shale Energy Development** (*Mike Lloyd, & Peggy Hall*) - Participants will review the shale energy development in Ohio. The group will explore Extension's Shale Programming and how it serves to educate landowners and communities about the development of Ohio's shale resources.
 - **BioEnergy Development** (*Alan Sundermeier*) - This session will provide a summary of bio-energy challenges and opportunities in Ohio. The group will discuss current bio-energy research projects at OSU and review bio-energy programming and tools currently available.
 - **Youth Energy Education** (*Mark Light & Bob Horton*) - This session will showcase youth program materials for wind, solar, biofuels, energy efficiency, and review ways to integrate STEM (science, technology, engineering, and math) education and energy into a curriculum tailored for the 4-H audience.
- 12:00 - 1:00** **Lunch** (*Pat Holmes*) - Several fun interactive activities will coincide with lunch to facilitate energy discussion and share demonstrated program impacts.
- 1:00 - 2:00** **How to Facilitate an Energy Efficiency Panel** (*Pat Holmes & Myra Moss*) - Explore tools and learn how to organize and facilitate a energy panel in your community. This panel will target extension clientele interested in investing in energy efficiency or renewable energy for their home or business.
- 2:00 - 2:30** **Closing Thoughts with Q&A** - The purpose of this closing session is to facilitate discussion to address any questions or concerns that were not directly addressed during the program. In addition, we hope to gather feedback on opportunities to improve the program and identify collaborative opportunities to deliver the signature program new counties throughout the state.
