
Total employment impact for the drilling oil and gas wells industry in 2020 was 3,309 total jobs which consisted of 1,176 jobs directly associated with the drilling oil and gas wells industry, 1,317 indirect jobs as a result of business to business transactions, and 816 induced jobs supported by household spending. The drilling oil and gas wells industry contributed a total of \$402.8 million in value added, including \$171.9 million in direct value added, \$157.3 million in indirect value added, and \$73.7 million of induced value added. In summary, in 2020 the drilling oil and gas wells industry accounted for 3.3% of the Ohio energy sectors total employment and 2% of the total value added. This technical bulletin summarizes the


